# **CHURCH NEWS**

I am sat enjoying the morning sun, 25 degrees forecast for today, 12,000 miles away in the Southern Hemisphere. We have travelled over 2,000 miles so far in a new hire car, delighting in beautiful scenery, especially turquoise blue seas, lovely weather and the care of friends and strangers. Just when we needed it, without asking, someone would come up and say "Can I help you?"

It was amazing when one morning, as we parked at the supermarket, the front tyre on our hire car looked a little flat. On returning to the car, a lady walked towards us, mentioned the tyre and told us where to locate a garage. "It may still be opened", it was 12.45pm on a Saturday. Just ten minutes later the mechanic removed the tyre, located a large thin nail and repaired the puncture. How thankful we were, as the next 350 miles of our journey was around the coastline and we may have been stranded! As we began our morning bible readings for March the theme was 'The Servant' - "Here is my Servant whom I uphold. My Chosen one in whom I delight". Isaiah 42 V1. Writing up my travel diary, I thanked the Lord for all those who had served us in many and varied ways, even before we had made a request. Then I thanked the Lord for 'His Servant', His only Son, the Lord Jesus Christ. God really loves

us, Jesus died to save us and whoever believes in Him will not perish but have everlasting life. John 3 V16.

Jesus made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant and coming in the likeness of men ... He Humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. Philippians 2 V7-8. Jesus is a Servant King; He stooped to conquer and suffered in order to reign. His is an upside down Kingdom.

On Easter Sunday morning at St. James Church, a roughly hewn wooden cross will be thatched with daffodils. Consider the daffodil bulb, perhaps you 'in faith' planted some in the dark earth, to endure the frost and cold of winter; their roots grow down to receive nourishment, the green shoot pushing through the frozen sod to emerge in the sun - a golden trumpet heralding the new life of Spring. This Easter time look afresh at Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy set before Him endured the cross despising the shame and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. Consider Jesus who endured such hostility from sinners against Himself so that you will not lose heart. Hebrews V1-3. He cried out from the cross "It is finished" and three days later rose triumphant from the grave.

We all look forward to when she will finish university and start earning money so she can support herself and us as a family.

I have completed my advanced level and now in my long vacation that ends in August, I have dedicated this time to housework and church ministry.....at church we pray together and have bible study and are about to start an income generating project where we shall be selling crafts to raise money to support our ministry .... I am Vice Chairperson and my title is 'mama'.



Meeting of the Parish Council, held on | Parish Councillors 17 March.

Councillors noted that the Griffe Grange application for wind turbines had been refused by 11 votes to 4 at the Southern District Planning Committee. A member of the public has once again raised the issue of cutting back the overgrowth in The Dale. Cllr. Purdy will continue to pursue it with Cllr. Ratcliffe.

Councillors discussed the problem of fly-tipping where Black Tor Road runs down to the Via Gellia. The Clerk will report this issue and for future reference. any member of the public can report any fly-tipping they see directly to the Environment Team at DDDC, either via the website or 01629 761215 or email environmenthotline@derbyshiredales. gov.uk. An additional litter bin is to be purchased for Park Bottom.


